The Greatest is "LOVE"

1 Corinthians 13 is a powerful chapter of scripture for a child of God. In these verses, God is telling us that our words of prophecy, understanding and all knowledge, even faith to the moving of mountains mean nothing without love. I told you last month "Love is the Foundation". Webster's Dictionary gives one definition of love as "A strong tender affection, deep devotion."
